



Application materials are now available for the upcoming United States Senate Youth Program (USSYP).

The USSYP provides an educational opportunity for <u>juniors</u> and <u>seniors</u> interested in pursuing college coursework in history or political science to spend a week in Washington D.C. meeting Senators, cabinet members, Supreme Court justices, and officials from various federal agencies and the White House.

Two student winners will be selected to represent North Carolina.

These two winners will each attend the Washington Week program, March 5-12, 2022, and receive a \$10,000 undergraduate college scholarship.

Mask Exemption Process for K-8 Students

The Mask Exemption Request Process will be shared with parents but we wanted our staff to have this information in case you are asked. In order to request an exemption, the following process will be followed:

- 1. Parents will pick up the exemption packet from their school principal.
- 2. Parents will return the completed exemption request and documentation to Mike Swain, Director of Student Services.
- 4. The Mask Exemption Committee will meet to review the request and documentation. The committee consists of the Director of Student Services, Assistant Director of Exceptional Children, a Classroom Teacher, the School Principal, and the Assistant Lead Nurse.
- 5. The committee will review all documentation and reach a decision based on an exemption formula.
- 6. Parents will be notified, in writing, of the decision reached within 5 business days from the date they submit the completed request packet.

Exemptions that were approved last year will remain in effect. Parents will not be required to request another exemption for this year. If an exemption was not approved, parents may submit again, with proper documentation. To make you aware, there were 82 exemption requests and of those, 74 were approved.

Reminder: All students MUST wear a cloth face mask when riding a school or activity bus. The Mask Exemptions do not apply to buses unless the exemption is based on transportation being a related service as noted in a student's IEP.



Online mCLASS with DIBELS 8th Edition Course Description

As part of the implementation of mCLASS with DIBELS 8th Edition for the 21-22 school year, all North Carolina educators will have access to a self-paced online course as a support for a successful implementation and to serve as a resource throughout the school year. You will not be able to create an account or access the course until July 7, 2021. To create an account click the **LINK**, enter your name and email, create a password, click sign up, and bookmark the course. It will be important to use a consistent log-in once you start the course so that you can generate a completion certificate

Upon completion participants will be able to:

Explain how mCLASS with DIBELS 8th Edition assesses the basic early literacy skills required for students to become proficient readers.

Administer and score mCLASS with DIBELS 8th Edition assessment measures for their grade level according to standardized guidelines.

Interpret student data and identify students' instructional needs.

Access targeted skills-focused lessons available in mCLASS DIBELS 8th Edition to plan differentiated instruction.

Generate a certificate of completion.




Early Childhood Department Meeting
