Course Description: This course is one of four required math classes for graduation. We will have 2 district benchmark tests and required NC End of Course Exam (EOC). This class will involve lots of class participation, group work/collaborative learning, projects, classwork, homework, and assessments. Notes - can be obtained in class or on canvas; will be completed daily.

Assignments - will be a daily downloadable worksheet, lesson check, desmos activity, or delta math assignment.

Activities/Projects - will be assigned as needed throughout the semester

Quizzes/Tests - will be completed in Schoolnet. Code will be posted in class only.

Classroom Rules / Expectations:

- **Daily Class Instruction:** Lessons will be completed daily via guided notes in class. If you are absent, it is your responsibility to obtain these notes from me or another classmate.
- **Weekly Playlist:** There will be a weekly playlist in Canvas consisting of each day's goals, tasks, and assignments. The playlist will be updated every week and should be used for planner checks and if you are absent.
- **Assignments/Homework:** Notes & Assignments (including warm ups) will be submitted on Canvas on a daily basis. If you don't keep up with the Weekly Playlist Schedule, you will get behind quickly. All assignments are graded and returned with 48 hours.
- **Missing/Late Assignment Policy:** Absent work is located in the missing work crate in the classroom or online in the canvas folder/weekly playlist. Assignments turned up to 5 days late will be docked 5 points and after 5 days will be docked 15 points. Late assignments will be graded as soon as possible. A zero will be entered for all assignments until it is turned in.
- **Tests/Quizzes:** All tests and quizzes must be made-up within 1 week.
